



Dr Ying Yan, Professor at Ocean University of China. She earned a Ph.D. in Aquatic Biology from the College of Fisheries at the same university in 2018. Following the completion of doctoral studies, Dr Yan pursued postdoctoral research at Smith College in the United States from 2018 to 2020. Dr Yan's research focuses on the genomics and gene evolution of ciliates. Employing a combination of genomics, cell biology, and molecular biology techniques, Dr Yan investigates ciliate genome evolution and regulatory mechanisms during cell division. Dr Yan has published over 30 SCI papers in journals such as *mBio*, *Science China Life Sciences*, and *Molecular Biology and Evolution*, with 25 of these articles being first-author or corresponding-author contributions. She is served as an editorial board member of *Marine Life Science & Technology*, and awarded as Young Expert of Taishan Scholars in Shandong Province.
