



# Full Day DELHI Tour for ISCB 2025 Delegates

# ltinerary:

Day 01 In Delhi
-----------------

Morning you will be picked from your hotel and proceed for a full day city tour of Old and New Delhi.

We start to explore the capital of Muslim India between the 12th and 20th centuries, the **Old Delhi**. We shall stop at the Red Fort for a photo shoot and then take a **Rickshaw Ride** through the narrow streets of the Old Delhi up to the nearby **Jama Masjid Mosque**, the largest in India, has a courtyard that can hold 25,000 worshippers.





Then pay a poignant visit to Rajghat, the site of Mahatma Gandhi's cremation and a memorial to this humble man who so changed the world. Then we move on to explore the **New Delhi** driving pass by the Vijay Chowk, "Victory Square", the **Presidential Palace** with its intriguing combination of classical and Indian design elements and the **India Gate** memorializing Indian soldiers who died in World War I.

Then we will visit the **Humayun's Tomb** the magnificent garden tomb is the first substantial example of Mughal architecture in India. It was built in 1565 A.D. nine years after the death of Humayun, by his senior widow Bega Begam. Inside the walled enclosure the most notable features are the garden squares (chaharbagh) with pathways water channels, centrally located well proportional mausoleum topped by double dome.

Finally we visit the **Qutab Minar**, the tallest brick minaret in the world. Qutbu'd-Din Aibak laid the foundation of Minar in AD 1199 for the use of the mu'azzin (crier) to give calls for prayer and raised the first storey, to which were added three more storeys by his successor and sonin-law, Shamsu'd-Din Iltutmish (AD 1211-36). All the storeys are surrounded by a projected balcony encircling the minar and supported by stone brackets, which are decorated with honey-comb design, more conspicuously in the first storey.
